



# DRIVING BASICS: Making right turns with bike lanes

## Example 1: Right turn with bike lane

**Where:** On John St. at Marlborough St.  
westbound.

**Lane Configuration:** Parking lane / Bike lane / Travel lane

### What to do:

1. Signal
2. Stay in lane – do not cross into bike lane – do not drive in parking lane
3. Stop at stop bar
4. Yield to pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists
5. When the way is clear, make your turn

**Remember:** It is illegal to drive in a bike lane or parking lane

## Example 2: Right turn with shared turn lane

**Where:** On Vickers St. at Miles St. northbound

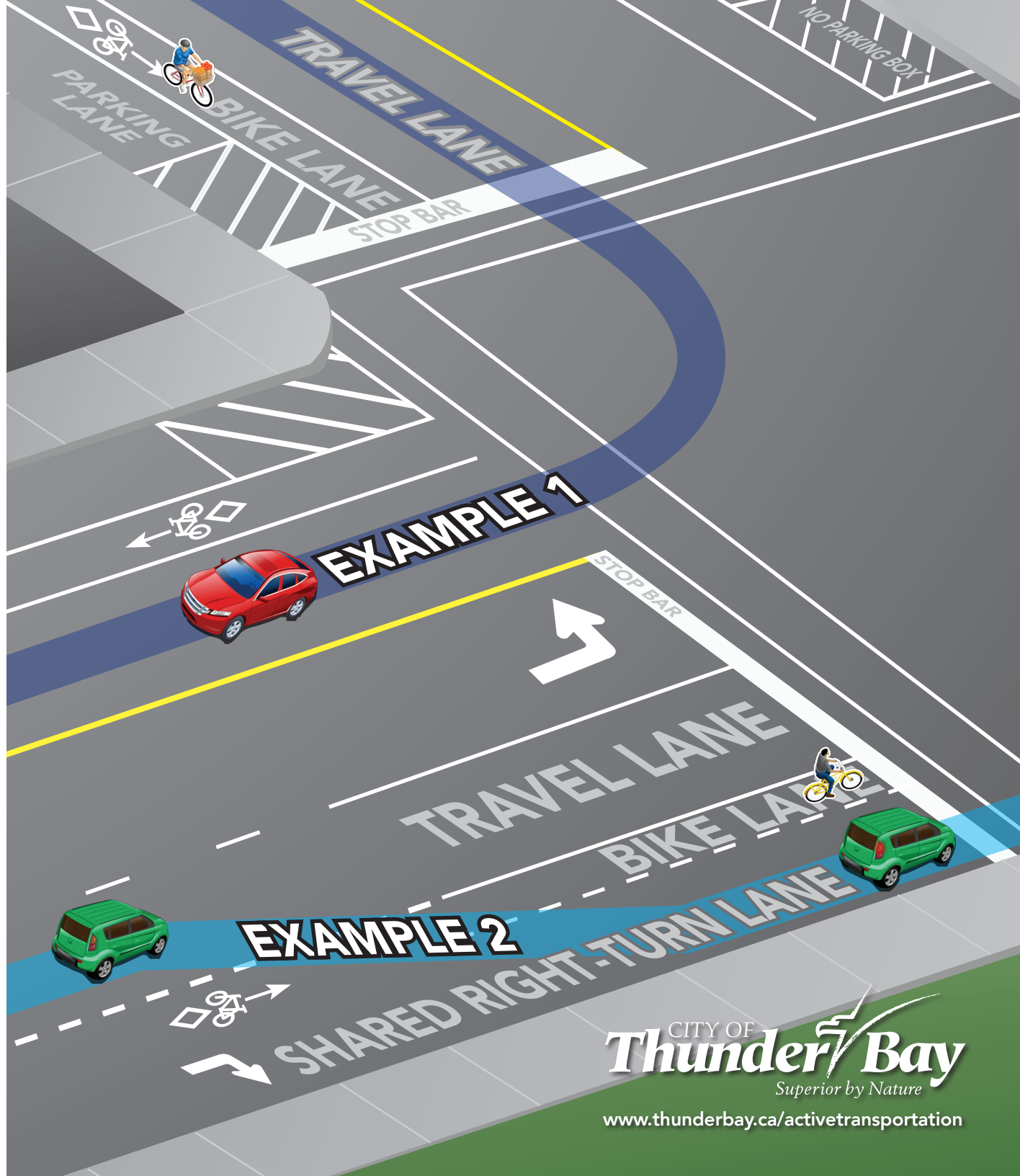
**Lane Configuration:** Shared right-turn lane / Travel lane

### What to do:

1. Look for broken white line
2. Signal
3. Check over your right shoulder, yield to cyclists
4. If clear, move into lane
5. Stop at stop bar
6. Yield to pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists
7. When the way is clear, make your turn

**Remember:** Whoever arrives at the Stop Bar first has the right-of-way

# BIKING BASICS: Riding with right-turning traffic

## Example 1: Right turn with bike lane

**Where:** On John St. at Marlborough St. westbound.

**Lane Configuration:** Parking lane / Bike lane / Travel lane

**What to do:** Riding through intersection

1. Stay in bike lane
2. Travel in a straight line through intersection

**What to do:** Right Turn

1. Stay in Bike Lane
2. Signal
3. Stop at stop bar
4. Yield to pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists
5. When the way is clear, make your turn

**Remember:** Cyclists have right-of-way over right-turning automobiles

## Example 2: Right turn with shared turn lane

**Where:** On Vickers St. at Miles St. northbound

**Lane Configuration:** Shared right-turn lane / Travel lane

**What to do:** Riding through intersection

1. Stay in your dotted bike lane
2. Allow motorists to merge into lane safely
3. Travel in a straight line through intersection

**What to do:** Right Turn

1. Check to see if curb lane is clear
2. Signal
3. Check traffic again
4. If clear, move to the curb
5. Stop at stop bar
6. Yield to pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists
7. When the way is clear, make your turn

**Remember:** Whoever arrives at the Stop Bar first has the right-of-way
