



Emerging Project Fund Application

Background Information:

This grant is targeted at the City of Thunder Bay's Departments and Committees. It is also available to Community Organizations. The grant is sponsored by Thunder Bay's Clean, Green & Beautiful (CGB) Committee whose mandate is to support projects that beautify our City and enhance civic pride. Clear, highly visible benefits to the community. Potential for long-term impact or must be high impact if project is for a shorter duration. Projects should align with or further the Clean, Green & Beautiful Committee's objectives. Must bring recognition of the Clean, Green & Beautiful Committee's contribution to further promote the Clean, Green & Beautiful Committee mandate. Upon completion of the project, a brief project description and report (up to 250 words) and a colour photograph must be filed for incorporation in Clean, Green & Beautiful Committee's reports and promotion.

Available for smaller scale projects (eligible for Clean, Green & Beautiful Committee contributions up to \$5,000) or to leverage funds from other levels of government and/or partnership contributions (cash or in kind). Larger contributions will be considered based on tangible community benefits and availability of funds. Studies, research, plans or administration fees, however important, are not eligible for funding from this source.

Evaluation:

The City's Clean, Green & Beautiful Committee will evaluate applications. Examples of eligible projects could include public art, community improvements (artistic painting, landscaping, improved seating areas or other), public education about civic pride, etc.)
