It is important that the person named for possible appointment is qualified to be an elector of the City of Thunder Bay, and has indicated a willingness to serve in that capacity before his or her name is submitted to the Office of the City Clerk. Applicants must reside and maintain residency in the City of Thunder Bay throughout their appointment.

The Committee will develop and recommend a four-year Action Plan with timelines, key priorities and measurable objectives and success indicators to eliminate racism and to promote equity, diversity and respect in the community of Thunder Bay.

The Committee will develop partnerships with community organizations, agencies and others to assist in identifying and addressing issues related to racism and the implementation of the Action Plan.
