

## **APPOINTMENT TO VICTORIAVILLE BOARD OF MANAGEMENT**

An invitation is extended to citizens of the City of Thunder Bay to submit their name to be considered for nomination by City Council to serve on the Victoriaville Board of Management.

The primary objectives of the Victoriaville Board of Management (the Board) are:

- The strategic vision and direction for the Victoriaville Centre (the Centre)
- Marketing, promotion and event planning
- Maximize public benefit of the Centre
- The safe, prudent, and cost effective operation of the Centre
- Maximize revenue for the Centre

To qualify, the nominee should have the following qualifications:

- Business experience and knowledge
- Independence of judgment and no self-interest in the Centre
- Must be a resident and/or property owner in the City of Thunder Bay or directly operate a business in the City of Thunder Bay

City Council is seeking four (4) representatives in the following areas:

- one (1) abutting owner, for a 2 year term, expiring November 30, 2020
- one (1) tenant of Victoriaville, for a 2 year term, expiring November 30, 2020
- two (2) citizens for a 4 year, expiring November 30, 2022

Those persons who have served previously on any of the foregoing local boards, and whose term of office expires, must re-apply in order that their names may once again be considered for nomination to whatever board they declare an interest in.
