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Under the provisions of the Municipal Act, it is necessary for Councils to appoint Auditors to examine and report on the accounts affecting the Corporation, or relating to any matter under its control or within its jurisdiction, for each year.

The City of Port Arthur appointed the firm of Black, Hanson & Co., whose name appears to have changed to F.H. Black & Co. in 1951, for the years 1942 – 1967. Clarkson, Gordon & Co. were the City’s auditors for the years 1968 and 1969.

The series consists of Auditor’s Reports, Treasurer’s Reports and Statements for the years 1942 – 1945, Annual Financial Statements for the years 1948, 1950 – 55, 1957 – 1959, 1961, 1962, 1964 and 1965, Audit Reports for the years 1949, and 1955 - 1960; the Audit Reports are duplicate copies, as it was required that the originals be sent to the Department of Municipal Affairs, Auditor’s Reports and Financial Statements for the years 1962 – 1964 and 1966 – 1969, Auditor's Reports for Road Expenditures for the years 1959-1963 & 1965-1968, Budget Books for 1967 and 1969, Financial Reports for 1968 and 1969, Public Utilities Commission Financial Statements for 1968 and 1969, as well as Financial Statements for the year 1969 for the City, Dawson Court, Lakehead Board of Education, Parking Authority and the Public Library Board.

There are no statements or reports for the years 1946 and 1947.

This series consists of two Accessions. Accession 1993-20 and Accession 2012-53. Accession 2012-53 is the Auditor's Report, Road Expenditures January 1-December 31, 1965. Custodial History is not known for this Accession. It was found in the multipurpose room and interfiled with the other Accession.

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Further accruals are not anticipated.
