

**Series 212 - Fort William Mountain View Cemetery
Records - Misc.**

Mountain View Cemetery is one of two municipally owned and operated cemeteries within The City of Thunder Bay. Previously under the jurisdiction of the City of Fort William, the ongoing maintenance of the Cemetery was overseen by the Board of Park Management, while the sale and transfer of lots at Mountain View Cemetery was overseen by the Office of the City Treasurer.

Mountain View Cemetery is now under the control of The City of Thunder Bay's Parks and Recreation Division.

Series consists of burial records produced by the Office of the City Treasurer, relating to the sale and transfer of burial lots at Mountain View Cemetery. Included are Burial Lists, Court Orders allowing for the sale of cemetery lands, correspondence, deeds and duplicate deeds. Burial Lists are arranged in date order and include the name and location of people buried at Mountain View Cemetery. Some later lists also include additional information such as the associated costs of burial and additional information about the individuals listed including the date of burial and the age of the deceased. Deeds confirm the payment of lots and show the amount paid for each lot and the purchaser's name.

Records are arranged in date order and by record type.
