The Nordic World Ski Championships have been held since 1925 and have focused upon the disciplines of cross country skiing, ski jumping, and nordic combined (a combination of cross country and ski jumping). In 1995 the games were held in Thunder Bay. This was only the second time in the history of the games that they were held outside of Europe. The event took place from March 9 - 19 at the Big Thunder national ski training centre.
