When the City of Port Arthur was designated as a planning area under the provisions of the Planning Act, 1946, it was necessary to appoint a Planning Board. This was accomplished through the passage of By-Law 3156, which became effective on January 1, 1951.

The files in this series were generated at the time Mr. T. B. McCormack was the City Planner and Secretary-Treasurer of the Planning Board, and appear to be files that were maintained by him.

The first three files, Numbered OP-1, OP-2 and OP-3 deal with the approval of the General Land Use Plan, Consolidation of Amendments and Amendment #7 to the Fort William Official Plan, respectively. The balance of the files, Numbered OPA-1 to OPA-38, relate to various amendments with respect to specific properties covered by the Official Plan.
