Members of Council,

The Thunder Bay Police Services Board met on January 25, 2022 to discuss the New Police Facility. As such, a motion was passed by the Board and sent through the Office of the City Clerk to request that the capital project be reduced from \$56 million to \$2.4 million. The original source of financing for the project was a debenture. Therefore a debenture is no longer pursued in 2022 and that it would be in Council’s best interest to determine a source of financing so as not to increase levy and further impact the tax payer.

As such, I present the following amendment to the revised submission from the TBPSB:

WITH RESPECT to the Memorandum from City Clerk Krista Power relative to a revised budget submission from the Thunder Bay Police Services Board dated January 26, 2022, we recommend that the following paragraph be added after paragraph two –

“AND THAT the source of funding be Renew Thunder Bay, notwithstanding the criteria established in the Renew Thunder Bay – Strategic Infrastructure Plan;”
