The Waterfront Trail Rotary Community Action Team (WTRCAT) is interested in making a deputation to City Council at their Pre-Budget Public Consultation session on Thursday January 13th.

The Waterfront Trail Rotary Community Action Team (WTRCAT) has been formed to be a community-backed Active Living-focused voice, advocating to see key pieces of the City's Waterfront Multi-Use Trail develop. In its simplest form, the boundaries of the Trail extend from Fisherman's Park in the North to Chippewa Park in the South or "Park-to-Park".

Our group is especially interested in three matters:

- 1. The capital commitment to the Waterfront Trail for the 2022 budget year and beyond;
- 2. An Operational commitment to planning and costing the segment of Trail between the Jackknife Bridge and James Street Swing Bridge and/or Chippewa Park;
- 3. Contingency funding of an Economic and Tourism Impact Study* of the Waterfront Trail covering funds not approved by the Tourism Investment Committee of the CEDC.

Note: The WTRCAT will be applying to the Tourism Investment Committee of the CEDC to undertake and Economic and Tourism Impact Study.

WTRCAT Team-Lead Warren Philp has been named to the Waterfront Development Committee of City Council for a four-year term. He will be promoting the positions of the WTRCAT when attending those Committee meetings.

The WTRCAT, through its affiliation with the Port Arthur Rotary, is seeking Charity status to assist with fundraising for the City's Waterfront Trail. Prior to undertaking that effort, the WTRCAT needs to see firm commitment from the City in their upcoming budget discussions in 2022 and 2023.

During our deputation, we plan to demonstrate our vision for the Waterfront Trail, the benefits a completed Trail would bring and how we see the project being funded.

Presenters from the WTRCAT may include: Warren Philp, Donna Ostrom and Alan Cranston.
