



# HOW CITY COUNCIL MAKES DECISIONS

## 1 STANDING COMMITTEE

Report is presented to appropriate Standing Committee (5 members of City Council)

- Committee may:
  - Recommend to approval to City Council
  - Refer (ask) for more information
  - Provide feedback
  - Receive for information only
- Public deputations may be requested and heard



\*In some cases, reports will go directly to City Council for a decision\*

## 2 ADMINISTRATION REVIEW AND CHANGES

- Administration will revise its report and include changes requested by Standing Committee before report goes to City Council



## 3 COUNCIL PRESENTATION

City Council will receive the reviewed report

- Report will include all information from Standing Committee review and any changes made
- Public feedback and deputations from Standing Committee will be included for information



## 4 COUNCIL DECISION

City Council will provide final approval or decision on matter, unless report is provided for information only

City Council can also:

- Refer it back to Administration or Standing Committee
- Defer the decision
- Amend the recommendations provided
