 - Refer (ask) for more information
 - Provide feedback
 - Receive for information only
- Public deputations may be requested and

2 ADMINISTRATION REVIEW AND CHANGES

 Administration will revise its report and include changes requested by Standing Committee before report goes to City Council



COUNCIL PRESENTATION

City Council will receive the reviewed report

- Report will include all information from Standing Committee review and any changes made
- Public feedback and deputations from Standing Committee will be included for information



COUNCIL DECISION

City Council will provide final approval or decision on matter, unless report is provided for information only

City Council can also:

- Refer it back to Administration or Standing Committee
- Defer the decision
- Amend the recommendations provided
