With respect to the memorandum from Ms. K. Power, dated October 23, 2020 relative to Bill 218: Supporting Ontario's Recovery and Municipal Elections Act, that proposes changes to the Municipal Elections Act, we recommend that a letter be sent to the Premier of Ontario, the Honourable Doug Ford; the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, Minister Steve Clark, the Association of Municipal Clerks and Treasurers of Ontario, Association of Municipalities of Ontario, and the Ontario's Big City Mayors (formerly LUMCO) with respect to the lack of consultation on the recommended changes to legislation that affects municipal councils and voters;

AND THAT municipalities be consulted with respect to changes that affect voting processes as outlined in the Municipal Elections Act;

AND THAT the Provincial Government continue to make changes and improvements to the Voters List as outlined in Bill 204, as well as provide for a review and recommendations and/or regulations that guide the application of alternate methods of voting in Ontario;
