INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To: Krista Power, City Clerk of the City of Thunder Bay Kenneth Charles Boshcoff Election Campaign 2022

I have audited the accompanying Financial Statements - Auditor's Report Form 4 ("Financial Statements") of Kenneth Charles Boshcoff ("candidate") which comprise the Statement of Assets and Liabilities as at December 31, 2022, and the Statement of Campaign Period Income and Expenses and Statement of Determination of Surplus or Deficit and Disposition of Surplus for the period from August 15, 2022 to December 31, 2022 (relating to the election held on October 24, 2022), and other explanatory information. The Financial Statements have been prepared by the candidate based on Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act. 1996.

Candidate's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The candidate is responsible for the preparation of the Financial Statements in accordance with Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, and for such internal control as the candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of Financial Statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on these Financial Statements based on my audit. I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the Financial Statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the Financial Statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the Financial Statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the candidate's preparation of the Financial Statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the candidate's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the candidate, if any, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for a qualified audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in an election campaign, the completeness of donations of goods and services and receipts and disbursements is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the candidate, and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income and expenses, assets and liabilities, and surplus / deficit.

Qualified Opinion

In my opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the Financial Statements of the candidate for the period ended December 31, 2022 are prepared in all material respects, in accordance with Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Distribution

The Financial Statements are prepared to assist the candidate to meet the requirements of Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996. As a result, the Financial Statements may not be suitable for another purpose. My report is intended solely for the candidate and Krista Power, City Clerk of the City of Thunder Bay and should not be distributed to or used by parties other than the candidate and the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing.
