BY-LAW NUMBER ...143... 19.95...

A By-law to amend By-law Number 45-1993, being a by-law for the regulation of Fireworks in the City of Thunder Bay;

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to amend By-law Number 45-1993 as hereinafter provided;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF THUNDER BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Subsection 2(2) of the said By-law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:
(2) The sale of low-hazard fireworks is prohibited within the City of Thunder Bay except on the following days:
(i) New Year's Day;
(ii) Victoria Day;
(iii) Canada Day;
(iv) Civic Holiday;
(v) Labour Day;
(vi) December 31st; and
(vii) the six days immediately preceding any of the days referred to in paragraphs (i) to (vi).
2. Subsection 3(1) of the said By-law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:
(1) The setting off of low-hazard fireworks without a permit is prohibited except on the following days:
(i) New Year's Day;
(ii) Victoria Day;
(iii) Canada Day;
(iv) Civic Holiday;
(v) Labour Day;
(vi) December 31st; and
(vii) the three days immediately preceding any of the days referred to in paragraphs (i) to (vi).
3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing hereof.
