- An individual, business or organization that demonstrates leadership that promotes respectful behaviour, and fosters the inclusion of culturally and socially diverse peoples
- An individual, business or organization that goes above and beyond their employment expectations and responsibilities to exemplify the principles of **respect**.
- Recipients of a previous **respect.** Award are not eligible
- Individuals holding political office are not eligible
