

ENBRIDGE GAS - NOTICE TO PERMIT HOLDER

Applicants are reminded that construction of any sort, including construction of accessory buildings, must not be over any underground natural gas facilities. Conflicts with the underground natural gas facilities are to be communicated to Enbridge Gas Inc., the local gas distribution company, during the early job planning stages.

As a reminder, underground natural gas facility locations must be requested even if not excavating (Reference – CSA B149.1 and CSA Z662 Standards). Applicants are also reminded that the issuance of a building permit IS NOT confirmation that Enbridge Gas Inc. has been contacted or that underground natural gas facilities are not present.

MINISTRY OF LABOUR - eNOP (NOTICE OF PROJECT)

Constructors can now use the Electronic Notice of Project (eNOP) Form to Notify the Ministry of labour. The form must be completed, Printed and signed. The signed copy must be posted in a conspicuous place at the project or be available at the project for review by an inspector.
