#### **GARBAGE COLLECTION**

- At the curb before 7 am collection day or after 4 pm on the previous day
- · Maximum 2 items:
  - 1 item = 1 can or bag of garbage;
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> item collected only if tagged
- Wrap broken glass/sharp objects
- Wrap, double bag & seal animal waste
- No item tag needed for 3rd item on the first collection day after New Year's, Victoria Day & Labour Day
- For garbage cart details, refer to thunderbay.ca/waste

#### **LEAF & YARD WASTE COLLECTION**

- Leaves, bundled branches and garden waste collection (spring & fall)
- · No grass clippings
- Kraft (paper bags) only no bag limit
- Bundle branches with rope must be less than 1 m/39" long; less than 61 cm/24" diameter

### **CONTAINER BY-LAW REQUIREMENTS**

- Maximum weight per item 18 kg/40 lbs
- Cardboard boxes may NOT be used for waste

# BAGS



## CANS



- · Black or green only
- 1.5 mm thick
- Tied to prevent spillage

Minimum Size: 66 cm wide x 91 cm high (26" x 36")

Maximum weight: 18 kg (40 lbs.)  Durable plastic/ metal containers with handles & tight-fitting lid (not secured to can)

Maximum combined weight of can & contents: 18 kg (40 lbs.)

Maximum volume: 135 L (30 gal)

Maximum height: 81 cm (32") without lid

### **SAFETY TIPS**

- No liquid waste, medical sharps (needles)
- · Construction waste (plaster) not accepted
- Place garbage at ground level (not on snowbanks)

**GREY LID - PAPER** 

- Household fine paper Paper egg cartons
- Boxboard boxes (e.g. cereal) · Corrugated cardboard
- **RECYCLING DEPOTS** Front St. at McIntvre St.
- · Mountdale Ave. at Walsh St.
- Solid Waste & Recycling Facility Mon. - Fri. 8 am-6:30 pm Saturdays - 8 am-4:30 pm Closed Sundays & holidays

#### **CURBSIDE RECYCLING AND TIPS**

- Sort your recyclables before placing them in your recycling cart. Place paper/cardboard materials in your grey lid and containers in your blue lid.
- Flatten and break down cardboard boxes. For excess cardboard that does not fit in cart, place in bundles beside cart (3 ft x 2 ft x 1 ft) broken down flat & tied with string.
- Place cart out by 7 am., on a flat surface, clear of snow and ice, at least 3 feet from fences, vehicles, or garbage.
- Place cart at the curb so that the wheels are away from the curb (toward your home).

Vehicles are charged based on weight of load. \$10 for less than 120 kg. Subject to change.

Loads must be secured and covered. Before leaving home, sort your load so materials can be taken off in these laydown areas:

- Recycling depot\* Metal bin
- Household Hazardous Waste Depot
- Garbage bin Tire bin
- Electronic waste bin
- Leaf & yard waste compost area
