GARBAGE COLLECTION

- At the curb before 7 am collection day or after 4 pm on the previous day
- Maximum 2 items:
 - garbage cart, issued by the city
 - 1 additional garbage bag, collected only if tagged
- Bag all garbage before placing in cart
- Animal waste, broken glass, and sharp objects must be bagged, sealed, and placed in garbage cart
- No item tag needed for one additional garbage bag on the first collection day after New Year's, Victoria Day & Labour Day

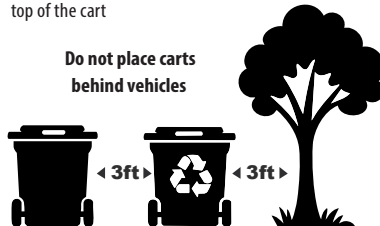
LEAF & YARD WASTE COLLECTION

- Leaves, bundled branches and garden waste collection (spring & fall)
- No grass clippings
- Kraft (paper bags) only – no bag limit
- Bundle branches with rope – must be less than 1 m/39" long; less than 61 cm/24" diameter

CONTAINER SET-OUT INSTRUCTIONS

- Truck arm must be able to reach and collect the cart
- Position cart on level ground, clear of snow and ice, with the arrow facing the road
- Space cart 3 feet from other objects
- Cart lid must be fully closed
- Additional tagged garbage bag, max. 40 lbs., must be placed on the ground next to the cart, not on top of the cart

Do not place carts behind vehicles



SAFETY TIPS

- No liquid waste or combustible materials
- No medical sharps (needles)
- No batteries or hazardous waste
- No construction or demolition waste

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dumping on streets or public property is illegal
- Householder is responsible for clean-up of improperly set out garbage

BLUE LID - CONTAINERS

- Containers: Glass, metal, plastic, coffee cups, foam
- Cartons (milk, juice)
- Aluminum (foil & trays)
- Tubes (deodorant, cream)
- Aerosol (empty, non-toxic)

GREY LID - PAPER & FIBRE

- Cardboard (flatten, 60cm x 60cm)
- Boxboard
- Paper laminates
- Paper
- **Flexible Plastic***

RECYCLING DEPOTS

- Front St. at McIntyre St.
- Mountdale Ave. at Walsh St.
- Solid Waste & Recycling Facility
Mon. - Fri. 8 am-6:30 pm
Saturdays - 8 am-4:30 pm
Closed Sundays & holidays

CURBSIDE RECYCLING AND TIPS

- Sort your recyclables before placing them in your recycling cart. Place containers in the blue lid. Paper & fibre materials, as well as flexible plastics, go into the grey lid.
- Flatten and break down cardboard boxes. For excess cardboard that does not fit in cart, place in bundles beside cart (3 ft x 2 ft x 1 ft) broken down flat & tied with string.
- Place cart out by 7 am, on a flat surface, clear of snow and ice, at least 3 feet from fences, vehicles, or garbage. Face cart towards the street.
- *Flexible plastic examples: plastic bags/wrap, bubble wrap, snack wrap, pouches, chip bags.
