MEALS ON WHEELS® – Its Purpose:

- To provide one home-delivered nourishing meal per weekday and a security check to eligible City of Thunder Bay residents
- To promote health through nutrition and social contact and help people stay independent at home.

Who May Subscribe to MEALS ON WHEELS®?

- Adult unable to regularly prepare adequate meals, due to chronic illness or convalescence, lack of strength, skill, motivation or cooking facilities
- Applicant who has no one at home who can prepare meals
- Applicant who can eat without help and can manage on weekends.
- Respite care for family caregivers.

When & How Often Can I Receive MEALS ON WHEELS®?

- Monday to Friday (including some statutory holidays). Weekend meal available delivered Friday with your hot meal
- Qualified volunteers deliver meals between 10:30am –12:30pm
- Client must be home to receive meal
- Any alternative delivery arrangements must be made prior to 9:30 am
- Clients may receive a maximum of 5 days/week or minimum of 2 days/week.
- Meals may be cancelled due to inclement weather or other emergencies.

What Is in MEALS ON WHEELS® And What Is the Cost?

- Hot, ready-to-eat entrée and soup, cold dessert
- Diet accommodation available
- \$8.20 per meal (no tax or delivery charge) billed monthly (Pre-Authorized Payment options available)
- Cold, ready-to-eat weekend meal (delivered Friday). Cost \$6.00 per meal.

How Can I Cancel a Meal or Discontinue the MEALS ON WHEELS® Service?

- To cancel a meal or meal service and avoid charges, call or leave message before 9:15a.m. on day of delivery. 24-hour voicemail
