

FUN THINGS TO DO WITH YOUR FAMILY OUTSIDE

Stargaze!
Lie down on a sheet on a clear night and make shapes in the stars.

Go camping!
Set up a "tent" with old sheets and tell stories

Make a "nature scrapbook" of things you find (grass, dandelions, sticks)

Backyard bowling (use empty bottles, soccer balls, etc.)

HOW TO PLAY "I'M GOING ON A CAMPING TRIP"

to play this game, you just need 3 or more people (note: you could even play over the phone, on Facetime, or over Zoom!)

the first person says "I'm going on a camping trip and I am going to bring..." they then will say something that will be the start of a pattern.

examples of patterns include:

- foods
- animals
- words starting or ending with a certain letter
- words that start with the same letter as the persons name (i.e. Jennifer would say a word with a "J", and Michael a word with an "M")

the rest of the group takes turns saying "can I bring...?" and try to solve the pattern.

the person who started can say "yes" or "no" depending on if they meet the pattern.

the round is over once everyone guesses the pattern, or gives up!
