Acceptance of Risks Form

I am aware of the physical risks and hazards inherent in squash and in my participation in a squash event which include but are not limited to:

- Muscular injuries resulting from vigorous physical exertion, rapid movements and quick turns and stops on court,
- Injuries to the eyes, teeth, face, and other parts of the body resulting from being hit by racquets or balls,
- Bruises, scrapes and other injuries resulting from falling to the floor or colliding with the wall or other players,
- Additional risks associated with my travel to and from the competition and associated with non-competitive activities related to the event.

By participating in this league, I am exposed to these risks. I agree to accept these risks and to release the organizers of responsibilities for any injuries I might receive while participating in the league. In this agreement, I understand " organizers " to include Squash Ontario regional squash associations, The Thunder Bay Squash Association Executive, owners/operators of the facility where the event is being held, sponsors and each of their respective directors, officers, employees, coaches, officials, volunteers and members.

I understand that wearing protective eye guards while playing squash significantly reduces the risk of eye or facial injury. Junior (minor) players must appropriately wear eye guards in this event. It is strongly recommended that all players appropriately wear protective eye guards at all times.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic there will be enhanced cleaning of the courts at the Canada Games Complex. This will include the cleaning of high touch areas after each booking and deep cleans of the courts daily.

COVID-19 Guidelines (Squash Ontario)

Below are the Return to Play Guidelines developed by the COVID-19 Return to Play Task Force through Squash Ontario that are in relation to the Court Jesters Squash League.

Squash and COVID-19

Squash is an individual contact sport played in close proximity within enclosed indoor spaces, and in Ontario has a significant demographic of "over-50" players. Consequently, squash has many risk factors for exposure to the virus which causes COVID-19, as well as potentially poorer COVID-19 outcomes. Due to these risk factors, all players returning to the sport must do so at their own risk and should seek further medical advice where necessary.

Permitted Activities:

- b. Singles Play: Two players may play squash if they are in the same household or social circle, or otherwise so long as:
 - i. both players are in the same Pod,
 - ii. both players are on the same Team and/or are playing with each other for personal training

purposes,

iii. prolonged or deliberate contact between players is specifically avoided, and

iv. players maintain a distance of at least 2 meters between them wherever possible.

c. For clarity, all other singles squash activity outside of the above must maintain a distance of at least 2 meters between players at all times.

f. No Touch Let Directive: Effective immediately, players are strictly prohibited from making any deliberate and/or prolonged contact with each other. As such, let provisions are expanded to ensure points can be re-played if there is a reasonable probability of interference and a subsequent good return. Deliberate and/or prolonged contact with your opponent will be subject to code of conduct.

g. It is recommended that, in place of eye guards, players wear a certified face shield (such as the IMask+) and/or a mask while on court.

Pods and Teams:

a. The maximum size of all Pods and Teams is currently 10 players.

b. Players can only be in one Pod/Team at a time; however, players may change from one Pod/Team to another a maximum of one time per month.

c. The administration of Pod/Team formation and changes (including composition, timing of changes, updating and posting lists, etc.) is to be managed by the facility/club.
