

Alcohol Policies

- The legal drinking age in Ontario is 19. Bartenders cannot serve alcohol to anyone under 19 years of age. Proper ID must be presented to event staff when requested if you appear under the age of 25.
- A maximum of 4 alcohol tickets may be available for purchase at one time (2 if at a sporting event).
- A maximum of 2 alcohol drinks will be served at any one time.
- Bartenders reserve the right to refuse service. It is against the law to provide alcohol to anyone who is intoxicated or appears to be at the point of intoxication.
- The bar will be closed at _____. Ticket sales end 30 minutes prior to the bar closing. There will be no "Last Call".
- Servers are not allowed to consume alcohol or recreational drugs prior to or during their shift(s).
