# RULES, REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS 2024

---

1. All season pass and green fee players **must register at the Clubhouse** and report to the Starter **prior** to playing every round of golf. Proof of registration will be issued. **No one shall start on any tee without permission from the Clubhouse Clerk or Starter.**
2. Please keep your receipt with you during the round and present it to our Rangers if requested.
3. Golfers are not permitted to commence play prior to the daily posted starting time.
4. **Golfers with a reserved tee time must register at least 15 minutes prior to the assigned time.** Late registration may result in loss of both the tee time and priority.
5. **No more than 4 players in a group** without permission from the Starter. The Clubhouse Clerk will join singles and doubles to form threesomes and foursomes.
6. Caddies are permitted on the course, however, they **are not allowed to play or practice.** Only those that have a paid green fee, and their own set of clubs (minimum 5 clubs) and bag may play. Permission may be granted for tournaments or for medical reasons on prior approval of the Supervisor of Golf.
7. Players stopping after their first nine for refreshments or otherwise, lose priority on the next nine.
8. **Safe Golf:** For the safety of golf course workers and players, golfers must wait to hit their ball until it is safe to do so. **Golf course workers have the right of way at all times.**
9. On occasion, certain greens and tees will be out of play because of maintenance work or weather conditions. Call ahead to find out course status. **Absolutely no play on the course while frost remains.**
10. The golf courses will be closed for regular play on occasion to facilitate **tournament events.** A list of tournaments will be posted. This list is subject to change. Golfers are encouraged to call before coming to the golf course.
11. **Metal spiked golf shoes are not allowed** on City golf courses. Soft spike golf shoes and tennis/runner style shoes are permitted.
12. **Pace of Play:** Golfers are expected to keep pace with the group ahead. If your group falls behind, you may be required to allow the following group to play through or you may have to pick up your ball and move forward in position. **The Ranger has the authority to keep play moving at a proper pace.**
13. Players are requested to replace their divots, repair ball marks on greens and rake sand traps. Power carts and pull carts must stay 25 feet from greens and tees.
14. **Power Carts:** You must be **18** and hold a valid driver's license to rent a power cart. Maximum of two riders per cart.
15. Usage of a power cart by holders of an annual cart rental pass is based on availability and is not guaranteed.
16. **Shirts and shoes** must be worn in the Clubhouse and all areas of the course. **No smoking allowed in the Clubhouse or outside patios.**
17. **Only alcoholic beverages purchased from the golf concession are allowed on the course.** No personal alcoholic beverages can be brought on property/ Abuse of this rule will result in confiscation of alcohol and/or ejection from golf course property with no refunds.
18. The Corporation of the City of Thunder Bay assumes no responsibility whatsoever for loss or damage to personal property or for personal injury to the golfer.
19. The golfer acknowledges that the game of golf involves inherent risks and assumes responsibility for any personal injuries sustained as a result of participating in this activity.
20. Owners of a season's pass will be required to purchase a green fee when participating in outside corporate functions being held at City golf courses.
21. Anyone who endangers or abuses golf course staff **in any way** will lose their golf privileges and be required to leave the facility.
22. Tee time reservations will consist of a 3 day advanced policy with telephone, online, or in person available bookings available every 8 minutes.
23. No shows for tee times are not acceptable and will be enforced with a \$50 no show cancellation fee. Restriction & Rules posted in ProShops
