WHAT'S HAPPENING IN 2025

As the Supervisor of Golf Services – Pat Berezowski, I would like to thank you for your support of Chapples and Strathcona Golf Courses. Membership was strong with 904 members and over 76,000 rounds recorded. Municipal golf provides a welcoming environment for anyone to try out the sport of golf. "Golf is Calling" in 2025 to try something new, meet new friends, and enjoy a sport for life.

The maintenance crews at both courses will continue to develop the turf quality throughout the property and there will be a few tee box projects in 2025. At Strathcona we will be doing some fairway thatching and seeding early in June to improve the turf thickness on the fairways. A few fairways at Chapples, 11 and 13 were overseeded last fall and we will continue to cultivate those areas which have had some issues in the last few years.

Tee time reservations will remain at 7am this season, online, in person and over the phone. Example would be calling on Sunday morning at 7am for a tee time on Wednesday. Tee time intervals will continue to be 8 min allowing more tee time opportunities. Be sure to watch the exact tee time you book this year.

NO show tee times have been significantly reduced over the last few years but everyone needs to be better at cancelling times. Our systems have the ability to take credit card upon booking and will move in that direction if the no show tee times don't see improvement. Ultimately, we are looking at support from all members to make this work in order to avoid a credit card ask for bookings. Thank you to those who continue to pass on the word to cancel your tee times if not required. Communication, signage, reminder confirmation emails and your commitment to a booked tee time will go along way to offering up more tee times to others that will be able to make that time.

Food and beverage operations will be supervised by Lynne Melnick this season and new staff postings will be on the City's website under jobs starting mid March. We have a great team environment and you will meet a lot of nice people in your day. Anyone can apply if they have smart serve and the food safety certification.
