Building orientation on Property:

- Building sits on the north side of the front portion of the property approximately 30 ft in from Algoma Street property line.

Current Building Use:

- Commercial Property – Dragonfly Lounge

Exterior Building Design / Materials:

- The exterior walls are stone (lower 3 ft of exterior wall) , brick (main floor exterior walls and verandah), cedar shakes (second floor exterior walls) and stucco (inside the arches on bottom portion of verandah)
- Second floor exterior walls are slightly arching at the bottom portion of the wall
- Arched brickwork below verandah windows
- Brickwork is a running bond design
- Arched window hoods over the second floor windows at the front of the house

- Square butt pattern design of siding material on exterior second floor walls

Roof Design/Materials:

- Cross gabled roof design
- Asphalt shingles
- Eaves are a unique design

Window Design:

- A variety of window designs - bay, double hung, casement and fixed
- Front bay windows were added in 1985

- Unique moldings around second floor windows

Additional Details:

- Square columns adorn the front verandah of the house
- Brick chimneys (2) are of a Tudor design
- Estimated building cost \$9000.00 (as listed on the building permit)
- 1428 square foot main floor
