Building orientation on Property:

- The house sits on the back portion of the property (approx 200 ft. from the Court St. property line) and is on the top of a steep incline that starts approx 150 ft from the Court St. P/L. The property levels out on the back 1/3 of the property (approx 80 ft.) where the house is located.

The elevation of the back portion of the property compared to Court St. is approx. 35ft.

Current Building Use:

- Home

Exterior Building Design / Materials:

- 1 ½ storey
- Main floor exterior walls are brick veneer.
- Gable ends are covered with siding
- Stone brickwork around front entrance door

- Front entrance is projected out from the main building and is one story high.

Roof Design/Materials:

- Cross gabled roof design
- Asphalt Shingles

Window Design:

- Casement windows and a larger front bay window
- Plain white moldings surround windows

Additional Details:

- The house is set on a higher elevation in comparison to Court St. which adds to the architectural significance of the home.
- Cement stairs lead up to the front door
- The property landscape is well maintained
